The 1995 summer and fall of torment is now behind us. What has been done to resolve native claims? Almost nothing.

My wife and I are both retired now, intending to rebuild our cottage and live quietly along the beach. These plans were radically changed last summer. We do not have to live with harrasement, fear of breakins or fire and delays of police roadblocks. We cannot afford decreased property values or pay out \$1,000.00 per year for legal fees as we have the past three years. I had one heart attack last December. Will I survive another?

Spring of 1996 is almost here. We don't need a repeat of last year. Native claims must be settled NOW in all fairness to the native people and with due consideration of the costs, stress and inconvenience to non native residents.
