To Whom It May Concern

For three years my wife and I who reside in Port Franks have suffered much stress. We have heard automatic gun fire in our back yard plus have had gun shot-gun pellets strike our home.

In the winter of 1993 crime increased dramatically with 9 break-ins in one night on either side of our home. All footmarks come from the army base and return to the army base. The fall of 1995 again the home on the borderline two doors from us was broken into with damage to 6 windows, and entry by breaking down door.

Winter of 1996 the same home entered, antique table, chesterfield, beds and other valuables taken. This home has been broken into 4 times within 4 months.

My wife and I bought this home 6 years ago as our heritage legally. There has been tremendous pressure brought to bare upon us. What is next?. We could not possibly sell our home at this time which is what we would like to do, because we are very very nervous of what will happen next. We do not want to any longer expose our children, grandchildren or friends to this explosive situation. A 12 year old child had to come to our home March 14th because of mixed communications at home, and was cold and hungry because he couldn't get into his home. He was very frightened walking to our home and carried with him a broken hockey stick for protection against the indians. He thought there had been an evacuation call and he was left alone.

The answer is accountability to this situation and we as law abiding tax papers all our lives need an answer.

Never in my wildest dreams did I ever think that my country would turn their back on me when I needed them the most!
